Local businesses told to compete online!

Australians are shopping on the internet for greater choice, not lower prices, meaning more domestic retailers should look at getting online, research suggests.

Almost one third of respondents said the main reason they shopped from overseas websites was to buy goods not available locally, according to a survey of 1500 online shoppers by market research firm The Leading Edge.

Only 19% said they shopped offshore because it was cheaper, a similar number to those that said they shopped internationally for a greater choice of products. The same survey found 23% of respondents shop only from Australian websites, while one third of those surveyed believe it is safer to shop domestically.

The research was commissioned by online payment system provider PayPal. PayPal managing director Frerk-Malte Feller said if local businesses could get their online strategy right, they could compete with international rivals for the growing online dollar.

"Our research paints a positive picture for domestic retailers," he said.

Delivery is the main challenge for online retailers, but Mr Feller predicted many businesses will be investing in distribution networks in the coming years in order to capitalise on the growing online market.



Facebook can build your business!

While face-to-face interaction is vital in the world of business, the reality is Facebook – and other social platforms like Instagram, Pinterest or Twitter – allows you to reach a much bigger audience much more efficiently. And this can turn into dollars in your hand.

Engagement versus likes

It's a fan base many businesses would envy. Facebook provides users with an array of statistics for each post. One useful measurement is "People talking about this". This figure is clearly displayed under the name of the business, under the main photo at the top of the page. According to Facebook, the number of "people talking about this" refers to "the number of people who have created a story from your page post.

Converting to sales

While some small business owners can't imagine having several team members dedicated to social media, Ramler says the investment is worth it. And he can see the results translate into cold hard cash.

The most interest statistic lies with "assisted conversions". Simplistically, this is where a prospect might visit and engage with the Facebook page of your business. But they may not buy straight away. Later, that person may search for a particular item and browse through multiple websites to compare prices and products. While browsing, they may land on your website and remember that they had previously engaged with your business on social media. If you've built trust, credibility and "social proof", they convert.

The key is to keep an open mind.. Your competitors may surpass you because they weren't afraid to embrace a new way of marketing.
